Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility and notification that we received confirmation yesterday of 64 new cases; 36 residents and 28 staff members, which brings our total number of cases since the onset of this pandemic to 123 residents and 80 staff members. We are extremely disappointed to see the significant rise in cases, especially since we have been working so hard to prevent the spread of this virus. As you know, there has been a surge of COVID-19 all over the country and when there is an increase in community spread there it will likely affect our facility, which it has. But we want to assure you that we are not discouraged by these new cases and will work tirelessly to keep our community safe to prevent further spread of this virus.

We will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
